



## **ABC's of registering an aircraft in the Cayman Islands**

The Civil Aviation Authority of the Cayman Islands (CAACI) is the statutory body responsible for aviation regulatory oversight throughout the Cayman Islands and for aircraft registered in the Cayman Islands.

The Cayman Islands Aircraft Registry is the registry of choice for many owners, financiers, management companies and other key decision makers. Stringent standards and a mandate for absolute safety guide our oversight of Cayman registered aircraft.

The CAACI is headquartered on Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands with a subsidiary support office in central London, UK. Our team at the head office in Grand Cayman or the UK office, work with clientele on annual plans to ensure deadlines are met and optimal flexibility afforded. Staff is familiar with Cayman Islands industry experts in the legal, financial and company registration sectors and will work to ensure sound, secure transactions.

- A) Basic process of registering an aircraft on the Cayman Islands register:
  - Submission of Registration Application & registration fee
  - Submission of Due Diligence Documentation
  - DGCA formerly accepts aircraft on the Register
  - The registration and certification process is initiated
  
- B) Eligibility
  - A UK or Overseas Territory entity
  - Commonwealth citizens
  - British protected persons
  - Bodies incorporated in some part of the Commonwealth
  
- C) Schedule of Fees
  - The cost of registration and maintenance of an aircraft on the Cayman is based on the weight with annual recurring charges. These may be calculated on the attached excel program entitled "Typical Cost Calculator"
  
- D) De-Registration
  - Payment of any outstanding invoices
  - Discharge of Mortgage (if applicable)
  - Return of Certificate of Registration (duly annotated on reverse side)
  - Issue of Export Certificate of Airworthiness (if required)
  - Notice of de-registration notified to new State of Operator
