

Dear Aviation Partner,

The Cayman Islands Government has announced the re-opening of the country's borders on 20 November 2021. During the response to COVID-19, there were special procedures enacted for air transport approvals. As we transition to phase 4 of the re-opening plan it is anticipated that there will be changes to the processes and procedures. As a part of its normal remit the CAACI continues to have regulatory oversight of all commercial air transport operations. For non-scheduled/charter operations please see attached application package with checklist and explanation of the process. Please submit all documents required on the checklist in order for the CAACI to process your application. Be advised that the processing time for these requests is 3 business days.

In addition, please note that all incoming passengers need to register with Travel Cayman and receive the appropriate approval prior to traveling to the jurisdiction. Please see <a href="https://www.exploregov.ky/travelcayman">https://www.exploregov.ky/travelcayman</a> for explanation of the process and links to the application. It is recommended that this information is shared with all passengers or others responsible for planning travel to the Cayman Islands.

Please direct all enquiries related to Cayman Islands' entry requirements, including vaccines, PCRs, lateral flow tests, quarantine etc., should be directed to the Travel Cayman, Travel Management Team at <a href="mailto:tcgat@gov.ky">tcgat@gov.ky</a>. Please also note that all travelers are required to use this <a href="mailto:form">form</a> to submit their PCR test.

Owen Roberts international Airport (GCM/MWCR) operate a scheduled facilitation requirement for all arrivals and departures. All operators are requested to have an approved handling agent and Slots can be submitted on your behalf by your ground handler. Alternatively, slots can be submitted through the Online Coordination system (OCS) if you have the required access at <a href="www.online-coordination.com">www.online-coordination.com</a>.
