

Dear Aviation Partner,

The Cayman Islands Government has announced the re-opening of the country's borders on 20 November 2021. During the response to COVID-19, there were special procedures enacted for air transport approvals. As we transition to phase 4 of the re-opening plan it is anticipated that there will be changes to the processes and procedure. In anticipation of the border opening, the CAACI are no longer required to provide approvals for private operations however charter operations/non-schedule commercial ops, i.e., Part 135 ops still require authorisation by the CAACI as per legal requirements, application package can be found at <https://www.caacayman.com/operating-permits/non-scheduled-operating-permits/> Please note that all operations are subject to ramp checks and verification of operating status.

Entry requirements for persons/inbound passengers are defined by the Cayman Islands Government via the Travel Cayman platform. All incoming passengers need to register with Travel Cayman. Please see <https://www.explore.gov.ky/travelcayman> for explanation of the process and links to the application. It is recommended that this information is shared with all passengers or others responsible for planning travel to the Cayman Islands.

Please direct all enquiries related to Cayman Islands' entry requirements, including vaccines, PCRs, lateral flow tests, quarantine etc., should be directed to the Travel Cayman, Travel Management Team at tcgat@gov.ky. Please also note that all travelers are required to use this [form](#) to submit their PCR test.

Owen Roberts international Airport (GCM/MWCR) operate a scheduled facilitation requirement for all arrivals and departures. All operators are requested to have an approved handling agent and Slots can be submitted on your behalf by your ground handler. Alternatively, slots can be submitted through the Online Coordination system (OCS) if you have the required access at www.online-coordination.com.
