The CAACI to exhibit at NBAA 2018

George Town, Grand Cayman (4 October 2018) - The Civil Aviation Authority of the Cayman Islands (CAACI) will exhibit at the National Business Aviation Association's (NBAA) Business Aviation Convention & Exhibition (BACE) tradeshow in Orlando, Florida on 16-18 November, 2018 to promote the Cayman Islands Aircraft Registry as the registry of choice for corporate and private aircraft and to raise the awareness to the Cayman Islands aviation industry in general.

The 2018 NBAA Business Aviation Convention & Exhibition (NBAA-BACE) is the world's largest and most important business aviation event. Ranked as the sixth largest tradeshow in the U.S., NBAA's convention, brings together key aviation contacts from around the world, including current and prospective business aircraft owners, manufacturers, operators, service providers and customers into one meeting place.
